The students of Cottonwood will be taking many assessments throughout the month of April and early May. Students in grades 3-5 began Kansas State Assessments on March 28 and end on April 13. The testing this year will include two sessions of Math and two sessions of Reading. Fifth grade will also take a Science assessment. Other assessments include MAP for grades 1 & 2, the BAS reading test for all grades, and ACT Aspire



for grades 3-5. The teachers have worked very hard preparing the students for these assessments. The students have also worked very hard in preparation for the tests. As parents, you can help by ensuring that your children are in attendance.

Research indicates that children who eat breakfast and attend school well-rested are more alert and able to concentrate on the task at hand. Making sure the students are getting adequate sleep and keeping a routine will truly benefit them during the testing weeks. The students will take occasional breaks during testing. If you would like to provide snacks for these breaks, please talk to your child's teacher.

Public schools are being required to become more accountable for student improvement. Test scores are the basis for this improvement. Please stress to your child the importance of putting forth their best effort on these tests.

In your child's classroom!


